Crane 1 All tower cranes including self erecting to be paid \$4.00 per hour over the Class A rate

Crane 2 All Lattice Boom Cranes and all other cranes with a manufacturer's rating of 50 ton (50) and over, to be paid \$3.00 per hour over Class A rate.

Crane 3 All hydraulic cranes and derricks with a manufacturer's rating of 49 ton and below, including boom trucks, to be paid \$2.00 per hour over class A rate

Crane rates apply with a Certificate of Competence is required by the New York State Department of Labor.

Dues deduction is to be calculated on the total package of gross wages plus benefits.

*This amount is to be deducted from wages after the appropriate taxes have been computed.
